It was my pleasure to be able to translate for God’s servants.

We also had a visit from Medical Missions Outreach which is a group of Christian Doctors, Nurses and medical providers to evangelize in Panama. I had the privilege to travel with them to Changinola, which is a town in the northwestern part of the country. This area is mainly banana plantations and most of the people who live in the area suffer with some vision problems due to the fumigation of the bananas. I was able to translate for the doctors and help with their physical



needs, while others had the opportunity to open their spiritual eyes to the Gospel. We spent four days there and approximately 1,400 people were treated. There were 686 precious souls who received spiritual sight and came to know the Lord as their personal Savior. Praise God that I could be part of reaching others for Him.

God has been so good! I am so thankful for all of those who have been praying for our family’s visas. Praise God that my wife Johanna and children Jatniel and Daryelis received them recently! Our plans are to travel to the U.S. in mid December and stay until April to visit supporting churches and share our plans to reach Chorrera for Christ.

Upon returning to Panama we plan to move to Chorrera to start a new work. Chorrera is the fastest growing city in all Panama. It is located 5 hours from David but just outside the Capital City. That is the part of this great country that the Lord has laid on our hearts to reach for Him. We have had the opportunity in the



last few month to travel to Chorrera and pray about where we can live and start the work. Please continue to pray that God will continue to open the doors to make this all possible.
